Sweetboy was saved from the pound with his eyes glued shut from matted hair. A 12 month old Schnauzer X, Sweetboy was saved from death row by DoggieRescue.com. Vet inspection involved shaving his face before being able to inspect his eyes. His fur was so badly matted that his eyes were glued shut and he could not see. The rubbing of the hair resulted in a large shallow ulcer in each eye. "It is hard to imagine the pain that this dog is going through and it could have been all so avoidable" says Monika, founder of DoggieRescue.com. "Sweetboy is now on pain relief and has vet treatment for his eyes. We hope that his sight will be restored in full."

He was named Sweetboy by the vets to reflect his gentle sweet nature. Despite him being so cruelly treated, he is the happiest little dog, trying to scamper around with his limited sight. "He is so loving and so gentle. DoggieRescue.com wants to ensure he will never be treated like this again!" says Monika.
