It was hard to believe that this much sought after breed (which typically costs several hundred dollars) had been discarded in the pound, unwanted and unloved.

After a bath, a clip and a brush Duckling was a new dog! He felt so much better with his clean fluffy coat, completely flea-ridden.

Since coming to DoggieRescue Duckling has made a slow but steady recovery. The angry redness of the skin is subsiding with antibiotics and medicated shampoo. His eyes are moist with eye drops and his hacking cough is diminishing after many sleepless nights. Duckling still sleeps most of the day but a few times, he has scampered about, following the other dogs. Best still he now has a hearty appetite. Small but significant improvements like this make it all worthwhile for DoggieRescue's volunteers, putting a smile on everyone's faces, including Ducklings.

Today Duckling has a lovely gentle nature and is easy going with other dogs. He is patiently waiting for a home where he will be treated like royalty.
