Unfortunately the fate of so many dogs in NSW is the lethal injection. Some 33,000 die each year and the vast majority are less than 3 years of age. DoggieRescue tries to save as many as we can from council pounds. Through our Doggie Rescue Life Saver program you can help us save more. Background

DoggieRescue.com is a registered charity with tax deductibility status. It has a strict No Kill philosophy and relies heavily on volunteers for all operational aspects. To date DoggieRescue has saved almost 9,000 dogs from death row from council pounds around Sydney and has some 200 dogs looking for homes. DoggieRescue currently has a shelter at Ingleside as well as many dogs in foster care throughout Sydney. It has recently launched its Life Saver program enabling dog lovers to support one doggie at the shelter on a regular basis.
