OWNERS CHOOSE TO EUTHANASE NEW PUPPY WITH BROKEN LEG

Bobby is a gorgeous 10 week old Pomeranian puppy, recently purchased as a family pet, who sustained a serious leg fracture. To repair it required an orthopaedic specialist and the owners opted to euthanase this otherwise completely healthy boy rather than look at options to mend the leg.

DoggieRescue received a call about Bobby and prompt liason between the vet clinic and the specialist meant that Bobby was attended to in next to no time. Bobby has come through the operation with flying colours and is hobbling around, desperate to play, but being kept calm to let the bones knit together.

Monika, founder of DoggieRescue says “It is hard to imagine how a person could callously put a pup down just because it has a broken leg. It shows how little thought went into getting the puppy in the first place, and you wonder how did such a bad fracture happen? Dogs are like small children and need to be treated with care and supervision” says Monika.

“Bobby is such a handsome little puppy, says Monika, “we are proud to have saved him”. DoggieRescue is currently looking for a family with commitment to see Bobby’s rehabilitation through and give him a forever home.

Background

DoggieRescue.com is Australia’s largest No-kill charity, in operation since 2001 with the primary objective to save dogs from death row from council pounds. It relies heavily on volunteers for all operational aspects. DoggieRescue has saved almost 10,000 dogs from death row from council pounds around Sydney and has some 200 dogs looking for homes.
