Moe was one of the many dogs we saved before Easter, but he stood out. Emaciated at 2.9kg with terrible teeth and gunky eyes, this little Maltese boy was a 11yo “senior” with no future.

“It is just amazing how quickly they improve with eye drops, antibiotics and good food, and knowing someone cares” says Monika, founder of DoggieRescue.com. “They see hope and they respond.” Moe is starting to eat well, with finely chopped soft foods. It took a while at first. A dental with lots of extractions meant he has a sore mouth for a while, but it heals and he will be able to chew again. His sore eyes are lubricated. He is around other gentle good natured dogs and he chills.

You begin to wonder how someone could abandon him at his mature age in such bad condition. He is such a sweet easy dog who is so hugely grateful for the care that is bestowed. This sweet easy boy would suit a family working longer hours or even an apartment style environment. Moe was one of the lucky ones who was saved from the pound. Many don't make it.

Wooky is another one saved last week. “This super cute guy did not come in as handsome as he is now” says Monika. “Even at 7 years of age he is a good looker – imagine what he looked like when he was younger! To add, Wooky has a happy bright personality.” He just wants to get on with life. He enjoys the company of other dogs, and is very affectionate and sooky without being needy. Both Moe and Wooky are small house dogs.
