Can you help feed our four legged friends?

Monika's Doggie Rescue is in urgent need of volunteer feeders. For the Ingleside based rescue organisation, "dinner time" is quite a monumental undertaking and more helpers are needed immediately.

With increasing apartment living making it harder for families to have pets in their lives, volunteering for Doggie Rescue gives many people their only opportunity to spend quality time with friendly, furry faces.

With over 100 mouths to feed, Founder and Manager Monika Biernacki explains that over 300kg of meat and around 15kg of rice is required every week to create the specially prepared meals.

"These are doggies that nobody wanted. Many have been underfed, even starved in the past and we are committed to returning them to good health and finding them a good home. This means a high quality diet of rice and mince provided by our wonderful volunteers."

Volunteers are provided with training and instruction and feeding is done on a rostered basis. After the feeding and washing up is finished volunteers are able to spend leisure time cuddling their favourite doggies and sharing some social time together.

There are also many other opportunities for volunteering at Doggie Rescue including dog walking, shelter maintenance, laundry, grooming, doggie transport and more.

DoggieRescue is a registered charity which operates a no-kill shelter at Ingleside in Sydney and also has many dogs in foster care in the metropolitan regions of Sydney.
