Our four legged friends need four wheels!

Monika's Doggie Rescue is in urgent need of volunteer drivers. With the Ingleside shelter looking after more than 100 dogs at any one time, this means more than a few trips to the vet.

With the help of North Rocks Veterinary Hospital, every Doggie Rescue dog receives the best in medical care, but getting them there requires serious logistical help.

Doggie Rescue **needs volunteer drivers to transport dogs from Ingleside to North Rocks**. These dogs may be getting desexed, receiving medical treatment or be lucky enough to have been saved from the pound and on their way to find their home through Doggie Rescue.

Ideally volunteers need:

- **Time to spare on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday mornings-** volunteers can offer as many or as few days as they would like
- **A car-** either one big enough to fit around 5 small dog crates, or a smaller car which can act as a back-up car.
- **Patience-** Some of the dogs may be a little nervous so they always appreciate your patience and kind words

There are also many other opportunities for volunteering at Doggie Rescue including dog walking, feeding, shelter maintenance, laundry, grooming and more.

DoggieRescue is a registered charity which operates a no-kill shelter at Ingleside in Sydney and also has many dogs in foster care in the metropolitan regions of Sydney.
