DoggieRescue founder, Monika Biernacki, is passionate about ensuring that every dog finds the right home; "There is someone out there who is the perfect match for every single dog that we have; whether they are big or small, young or old, active or quiet - we just need to make that connection." said Monika.

All of the dogs are listed on the charity's website, [www.DoggieRescue.com](http://www.DoggieRescue.com), but with so many available, finding the right one could take some time. But recent updates to the search facility mean that in seconds people can now get a shortlist of potential matches.

The easy to use search function has a wide range of filters and options to select from and based on the user's selection, instantly identifies the best possible matches. From the basics like age, sex and size of the dog, the system also has more detailed search criteria such as if they need to be good with kids (or cats!), are low shedding or would suit apartment living. You can even search based on your working lifestyle to find a four-legged companion who would suit full-time, part-time or home-based workers.

According to Ms.Biernacki , the new technology is going to be a great help. "I am so excited by this new doggie search feature. In just a few clicks people can view a range of doggies that might just be the one for them."

The team at DoggieRescue believe that they are one of only a handful of animal charities in Australia able to offer this level of detailed search options to potential adopters.

"The new search function speeds things up so much, and the high level of matching means we are more likely to progress to a successful adoption. While everyone still needs to complete the formal adoption process, the new search function makes the first stage so much easier. And the more adoptions we can achieve, the more space is available to rescue those dogs sitting on death row in the pound." said Monika
