4 week old Poodle pup left for dead

Annie a 5 week old Poodle pup was sent to the pound at 4 weeks of age by a breeder when it was ascertained that the pup was blind.

DoggieRescue was called to help. "Puppies should not leave their mother until they are 8 weeks of age so Mum can give them the tools for life, so they can survive." says Monika, Founder of DoggieRescue. "What sort of a chance does a disabled pup have at such a young age?"

Annie is not only blind but has been dumped with a dislocated shoulder at an age where she is totally helpless. "It makes you wonder how she came to have a dislocated shoulder as well as be blind!" asks Monika.

DoggieRescue vets at The Cottage Animal Hospital have done x rays and are consulting with an orthopaedic surgeon to assess what can be done to give Annie the best quality of life.

"The poor little girl --- all I want to do is hug her! How can someone do such a callous deed?" says Monika
